We hold one of the remaining two Military Travelling Warrants left active, under the Irish Constitution. This means that we can hold a Lodge meeting anywhere and on any date we choose, except for Sundays, Good Friday or Christmas Day. In practice, we visit other lodges, usually in England and the format is as follows:

You hold your Lodge meeting, which needs to be a simple business meeting, and close.

We then take over the room, preferably no later than 6.15 pm and hold a full meeting, starting with normal business and then exemplifying a ceremony. As we are under the Irish Constitution, we use the workings of the Grand Lodge of Ireland, which are quite different to those of the English Constitution, and which most English Masons find of great interest.

When we have concluded our business, we then Join you at your Festive Board.

As a matter of courtesy, we would appreciate our Worshipful Master being seated next to yours at the Festive Board.

Our Director of Ceremonies would require a list of Grand Officers, Names and Ranks forwarded to him prior to the meeting to allow him to establish the necessary protocols.

As we travel quite considerable distances to attend meetings, we would appreciate light refreshments being made available for us prior to the meeting.
